3. Day-to-Day Decisions. Each parent will make day-to-day decisions regarding the care 2 and control of the children during their scheduled parenting time. This includes any 3 emergency decisions which may affect a child's health or safety. Each parent shall be 4 supportive of the other's parenting style even if it differs from their own.
